Annex 2 Notifications

The Garda HQ Directive 10/2010 requiring notifications to GSOC came into effect on the 26th January 2010, and requires members of the Garda Sichdina to notify GSOC of the discharge of a fream, or less lethal device within 48 hours using an Annex 2 Notification form. These notifications involve the discharge of a Garda Issue firearm or less lethal device which does aget result in the death of, or serious harm to a person. These notifications are on a non-statutory basis, and GSOC only has records of the incidents that it is notified about by the Garda Siochána. The tables below shows the number of Annex 2 notifications received by GSOC involving the discharge of a less-lethal weapon/firearm for the year 2020.

Referrals/Public Interest Investigations

GSOC may also undertake an investigation involving the discharge of a Garda issue firearm or less lethal device that results in the death of, or serious harm to a person. Such an investigation requires a *referral* to be made to GSOC by the Garda Commissioner pursuant to section 102(1) of the Garda Síochána Act, 2005 (as amended).

GSOC also has the power to initiate a <u>public interest investigation</u> in accordance with section 102(4) in the absence of a complaint or referral from the Garda Commissioner. GSOC may initiate an investigation under section 102(4) based on information contained within an Annex 2 notification, or if it is made aware of a particular incident through other means.

Each of the GSOC investigations into the discharge of a firearm by a garda member was initiated either on foot of a s.102 (1) referral from the Garda Commissioner. There were no public interest investigations conducted under s.102 (4) for the year 2020. Information in relation to the investigations is listed below – where a notification under Directive 10/2010 was received for the same incident this has been indicated.
